If I has to say sth, I would mention the duration of the program. A week is ok for students to get to know each other and to progress, but a longer period would be better to see the further benefits of the project.

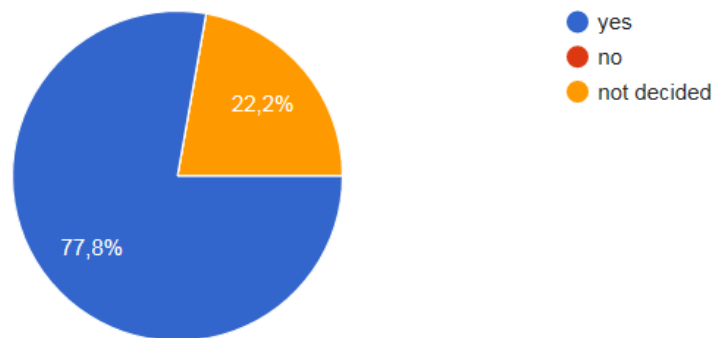
