THE FIRE TOWER, BUCHAREST. The Fire Tower or the Suicide Tower is one of the oldest buildings in Bucharest. The building, shrouded in mystery, is a real magnet for paranormal enthusiasts across the country. It is rumored that on the 9th of each month, just before midnight, the rooms in the fire Tower are inexplicably lit from the inside. It is assumed that the source of these strange phenomena is the ghost of a firefighter's wife who, convinced that her husband is cheating on her with another woman, comes to fire Tower to catch him in fact, but hurries falls from the second floor and dies. Legend has it that the woman's ghost is still circling the place to prove her husband's infidelity.



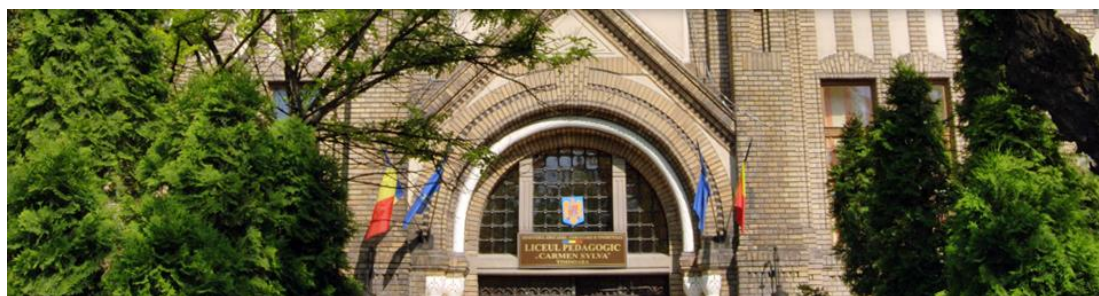


HOIA-BACIU FOREST, CLUJ. Hoia-Baciu Forest is known worldwide for the inexplicable phenomena that have occurred in the area over time. From burning sensations on the skin, to UFO sightings, the locals near the forest felt and saw them all. Dozens of researchers come here every year to study the fluctuations of the electromagnetic field and try to find scientific explanations for all the events that the locals have reported. They say that in the Hoia-Baciu Forest, voices are frequently heard, strange lights are seen that do not have a clear source and have strange sensations on the skin as soon as they walk in the forest.



THE CASINO FROM CONSTANTIA. The building-symbol of Constantia is often the subject of discussion among tourists due to the inexplicable phenomena that occur in the building. The origin of the phenomena is very surprising. Although there have been numerous suicides of players losing their fortunes in casino rooms, it seems that they were not the cause of the strange noises that are heard during the night, but a group of french soldiers. The bones of the soldiers were found at the beginning of the construction, thus disturbing the eternal place of the french who died of cholera. Legend has it that the soldiers awoke from their eternal sleep and disturbed the silence of the casino's visitors since the inauguration of the building.





CARMEN SYLVA HIGH SCHOOL, TIMISOARA. Urban myths from Timisoara claim that the high school is haunted by the ghosts of the former patients of the building that once functioned as a hospital. Here, the plague-sufferers went through terrible torments before dying of the relentless disease. According to the locals, in high school the screams of pain of the patients tormented by the disease called "black death" can be heard.



JEAN TROIANOS HOUSE, BRAILA. The legend of Master Manole who built Ana for the edifice of Curtea de Arges to last is not the only story of this kind in Romania. It seems that in Braila there is a building that shares the same story. The first owner, Nicolachi Mavrocordulas, built his wife on the walls of the house after learning that she had cheated on him. The employees who take care of the building say that the ghost of Mavrocordulas' wife is still haunting the place in search of justice.





CHIAJNA MONASTERY, BUCHAREST. If you had thought that besides the places of worship, evil spirits do not appear, the inhabitants near the Chiajna monastery claim that in their locality, the Lord's House is haunted by ghosts. Every time the bells are rung, the faithful cross themselves and pray to God to guard them, because the monastery has never had a bell and it is not known even now where the strange noises are heard.





BRAN CASTLE, BRASOV. Legend has it that Vlad Tepes's ghost haunts Bran Castle, but the story does not end here. And the spirit of Queen Mary would be within these walls. While renovating, some workers said they heard the woman's footsteps and smelled violets, the queen's favorite flowers.
