

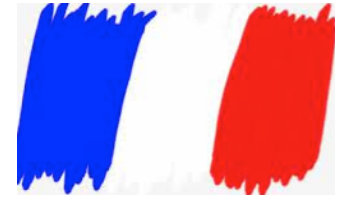

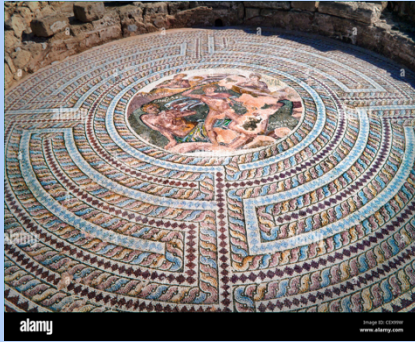

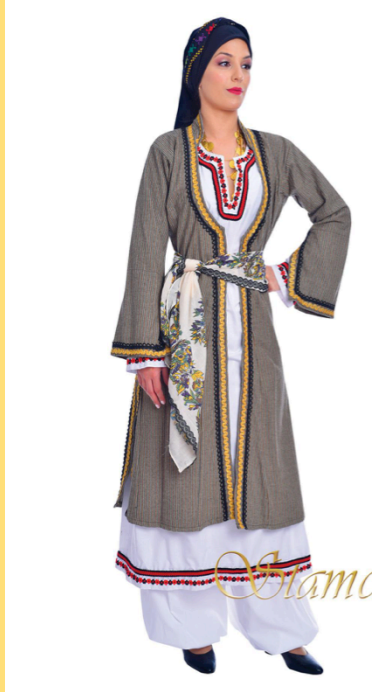

Cyprus Culture - Traditional Costumes



Traditional Cypriot women's clothing includes the "**saiya**," a **dress worn with a shirt, a formal dress and "the urban": a wide silk shirt, a short-sleeved jacket and a fez or shawl.**



Traditional Cypriot men's clothing includes silk shirts, waistcoats called "**zimbouni**", baggy cotton trousers called "**vraka**", woven belts called "**zostra**", fez hats, socks and shoes, and some kind of outerwear as traditional attire. The traditional shirts are typically silk, especially festive garments.

Cyprus Culture - Traditional Food



Traditional Cypriot foods include souvlakia (grilled meat kebabs), shaftalia (grilled sausage), afella (pork marinated in coriander), fried halloumi cheese, olives, pitta bread, kolokasi (root vegetables), lamb, artichokes, chickpeas and rabbit stews (stifado).

The House of Parliament is the third largest administrative building in the world.



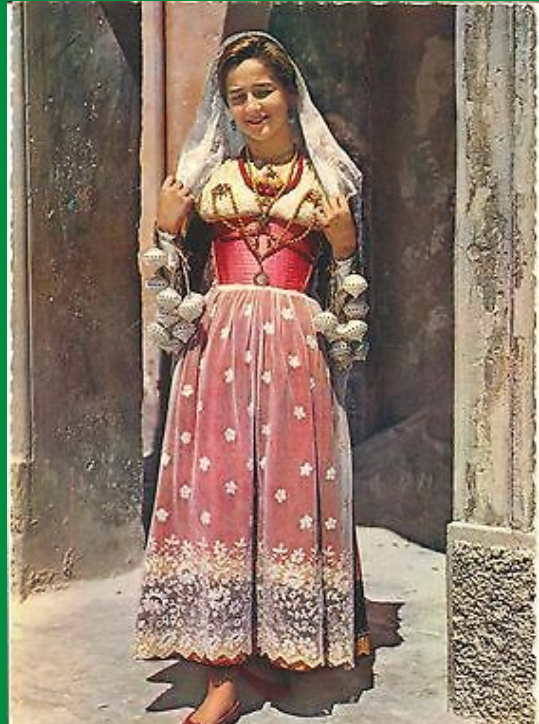
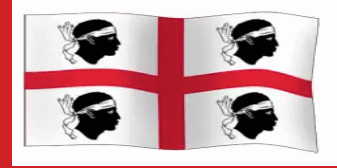
The Merry Cemetery

Costumes of Sardinia



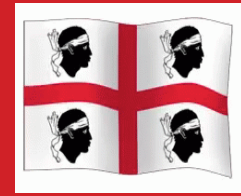
Traditional woman's dress is: colorful; rich; sumptuous and varied. It consists of the cap, a white shirt and corset. Gold, silver, coral and pearl jewelry are used as decoration.



The typical elements of the male costumes are: the cap; the shirt; the waistcoat; the jacket; the white linen trousers and the characteristic "gabbanu".

The Nuraghi are ancient stone constructions with a truncated cone shape present, with different concentrations, throughout Sardinia; they are unique in their kind and representative of the Nuragic civilization, which owes its name to them.

The seada is a typical dish of the Sardinian tradition based on semolina, cheese, as a condiment. They are often seasoned with honey or sugar,



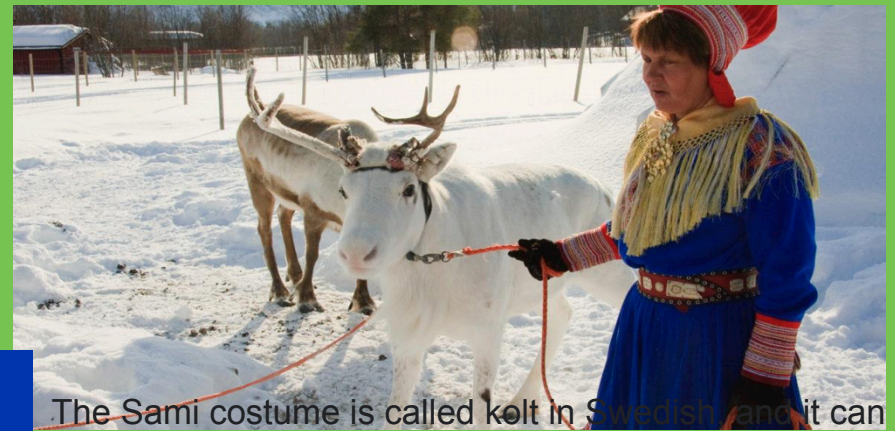
Sardinian piglet is a typical delicacy of Sardinia: a historical dish and a backbone of the island's culinary tradition.
